## 2026 UNIFORM RULES and FAQs

At Wagga Wagga Christian College, the wearing of uniform and the general presentation of our students reflects principles of:

- **Safety** – the safety of our students is always our paramount consideration
- **Dignity** – the College uniform should care for students, providing modesty and comfort
- **Belonging** – promotes that students are part of community
- **Equity** – accessible cost, uniformity that removes the fashion and appearance pressure that children and especially adolescents may feel
- **Practical** – purpose designed uniform that balances the learning work of students and enables active play

Sports Uniform	<p>The College Sports uniform is unisex and consistent across K-12:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Polo shirt (Maroon with navy stripe) - long or short sleeve</li> <li>• Coolmesh Shorts (navy with maroon stripe) or sports pants (navy with maroon stripe)</li> </ul>
Formal Uniform:	<p><b>K-12 Girls</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Summer: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ K-10: Summer dress or short-sleeved white shirt and navy shorts/trousers</li> <li>○ Years 11-12 only: may wear white shirt with navy skirt, shorts or trousers</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Winter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Long sleeved white blouse with navy trousers OR</li> <li>○ K-6 Maroon tartan tunic, with long-sleeved white shirt underneath, with navy tights</li> <li>○ Years 5-10 only: may wear white shirt with tartan skirt and navy tights</li> <li>○ Years 11-12 only: may wear white shirt with navy skirt and navy tights</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>K-12 Boys</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Summer: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Short-sleeved white shirt and navy shorts/trousers</li> <li>○ K-8 only: may wear maroon polo (alternative to white shirt) and navy shorts/trousers</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Winter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Long-sleeved white shirt (tucked in) and navy trousers</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tights are only worn with skirts or tunic</li> <li>• Students may not wear long sleeve shirts with shorts</li> </ul>
Hats:	<p>At recess and lunch in Terms 1 and 4, students must wear a navy hat, or they will be required to be in full shade.</p>

Jewellery:	<p>In general, jewellery is not to be worn at the College except for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A non-smart watch (digital is ok, but no apps, Bluetooth or internet connectivity).</li> <li>• Girls only may wear two pairs of plain gold/silver earrings, which may be either a small sleeper or stud (<math>\leq 1\text{cm}</math>).</li> <li>• Clear keeper earrings may be worn.</li> <li>• A single plain gold/silver chain necklace may be worn under clothes.</li> </ul>
Makeup:	<p>In general, make up is not to be worn by students except for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Light foundation is acceptable</li> <li>• Light coloured lip gloss or lip balm is acceptable</li> <li>• Light coloured nail polish is appropriate</li> </ul> <p>Long nails, gel nails, and nail decorations are not permitted.</p>
Hair:	<p>Hair should be entirely of naturally occurring hair colour. Hair accessories should be appropriate and in school colours (white, navy blue or maroon)</p>
Socks:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain white socks for sports uniform for boys and girls</li> <li>• Plain navy socks for trousers or shorts for boys and girls</li> <li>• Plain white socks with the summer dress</li> <li>• Socks are to be ankle length</li> <li>• Girls wear navy blue tights with winter skirt/tunic</li> <li>• 11-12: Plain navy socks with the navy skirt</li> </ul>
Dresses/Skirts	<p>Dresses/skirts should be knee length.</p>
Shorts	<p>Shorts should be at least to mid-thigh in length.</p>
Tie	<p>Wearing a College tie is compulsory as part of the boys' winter uniform from Year 5 – 12 (optional for K-4). When wearing a tie, the top button must be done up.</p>
Options for Cold Days:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Navy <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> zip fleece jumper</li> <li>• Navy soft shell jacket</li> <li>• Maroon wool blend jumper</li> </ul> <p>On very cold days in winter, students may wear:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain navy blue scarves, beanies or gloves may be worn <b>when outside</b>.</li> <li>• Students may wear additional layers under their uniform that are either plain white or flesh-toned with no slogans or images (e.g., thermals or singlets). The underlayers should not extend beyond the College uniform worn (e.g. students may not wear long-sleeved underlayers with short-sleeved shirts).</li> <li>• Non-uniform jumpers/hoodies/jackets may not be worn (including as underlayers).</li> </ul>

**Sport Uniform Shoes:**

Must be sport shoes/joggers and not casual shoes. Key features required are:

- Lace up (not slip on) – (Velcro for K-2 is ok)
- Covers the top of the foot
- Provides arch and ankle support
- Adequate grip on the sole (i.e., not smooth sole)
- Conservative colours (mainly black or white)
- Minimal other colours (e.g. accent/trim only)

**Formal Uniform Shoes:**

Must be black, (Years 7-12 upper-leather) shoes. Key features required are:

- Black (Leather for Years 7-12)
- Lace up (not slip-on) – (velcro for K-2 is ok; elastic-sided boots for boys only are ok)
- Covers the top of the foot
- Stepped heel (no higher than 3cm)

In Secondary School, leather shoes are required for all practical lessons (e.g. science and technology) regardless of whether the student is in sports uniform for any reason on that day.

**Primary only** may wear black sport style shoes and mary jane style shoes.

**Mufti Day Rules:**

On Mufti Days students may wear casual clothing for the day to raise money for a selected charity. Mufti days are a privilege, and the following rules are still required on these days.

- Safety must be maintained:
  - Jewellery rules are unchanged for mufti days
  - Safe closed in shoes must always be worn (no thongs, crocs, ugs, slippers, heels, etc)
- Modesty must be maintained:
  - No string tops, bare midriffs/back, low neck lines, low worn pants, short shorts/skirts.
- Offensive images or slogans will not be permitted

If in the College's discretion these rules are breached, a parent may be required to pick up their child from the College or provide suitable clothing.
